2025:THEYEAR OF YOUR BIBLE

From Pastor Andy Nash

Dear Church Family,

Happy New Year! What if this year became your BEST year in God's Word?

Here are three tools for your journey:

I. Treat Yourself to a Special New Bible.

My favorite Bible is the Hebrew-Greek Key Word Study Bible, with an easy-to-use numbering system that helps you go deeper in the text. The local ABC has this Bible and many other great Bibles you can go see personally.

2. Do a Bible Reading Plan.

There are different ways to walk, run, and fly through Scripture. The best way to study the Bible is verse-by-verse, book by book. That's what we'll be doing in our sermon time. But there are other methods as well. You could read through the Bible intensively in a month (a spiritual system shock that changed my life), or more slowly in a year. You can read the books of the Bible in their traditional order, or read them chronologically.

IOIN OUR 40-WEEK CHALLENGE.

If you'd like to do a 40-week chronological reading plan, I invite you to join Cindy and me for this experience. Along with the 40-Week Reading Plan included here, we'll have a weekly online discussion via Zoom and Facebook Live. Our first online discussion will be Thursday, January 9, at 7:00 p.m. eastern time - on the book of Genesis. So starting the first week of January, please read the book of Genesis in preparation for our January 9 discussion.

3. Go Deep in Daniel.

On Sabbath, January II, we're beginning a new sermon series on the book of Daniel. Daniel prophesied that in the last days believers would "run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase" (Dan. 12:4, NKJV). This beautiful imagery depicts believers running back and forth in the scrolls of Scripture, and being given greater understanding than even Daniel himself!

Pastor Keith and I invite you to study ahead in Daniel each week before our sermons.


